



Parking FAQ

Our parking system was developed with input from our patients and members of our Patient Advisory Council. They told us patients and visitors want more flexibility and choices in parking rates when parking at Health Sciences North.

1) Parking Lots

*Some parking lots are **Patient/Visitor Lots**. These lots are located closer to the buildings and offer a pay-as-you-go system where you only pay for the time you actually need.*

*There are also **Staff/Visitor Lots** which are located further away from the buildings. You are welcome to park in these lots. Parking fees for these lots are offered on a pay-as-you-go system where you only pay for the time you actually need to a maximum of \$6.*

*A \$10.00 daily pass that allows unlimited access for a 24-hour period can be purchased from any Pay Station and will provide you with access to either the **Patient/Visitor Lots** or the **Staff/Visitor Lots**.*

*Additionally, **Pay and Display** is available in front of the Northeast Cancer Centre. Parking Meters are also available at both the Ramsey Lake Health Centre and the Sudbury Outpatient Centre.*

2) Why do we have to pay for parking at the hospital?

Hospitals in Ontario do not receive any funding from the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care for any costs related to parking lots. These costs include maintenance such as snow removal and equipment such as the parking gates and pay stations. Every dollar received by HSN in net parking revenue helps us fund critical research in five areas:

- *Cancer Solutions*
- *Infection & Immunity*
- *Personalized Medicine*
- *Healthy Aging*
- *Northern & Indigenous Health*



3) Parking Costs

Different rates will apply to the different types of parking lots:

Patient/Visitor Lots <i>(Ramsey Lake Health Centre: P2A, P3, P4, P7 and P9 Sudbury Outpatient Clinic – side parking lot)</i>

1 day pass (Unlimited in/out for 24 hours to all Patient/Visitor and Staff/Visitor parking lots. Not valid in the Pay & Display lot or at parking meters.)	\$10
Staff/Visitor Lots <i>(Ramsey Lake Health Centre: P1, P2 and P5A)</i>	
Per exit	\$6
1 day pass (Unlimited in/out for 24 hours to all Patient/Visitor and Staff/Visitor parking lots. Not valid in the Pay & Display lot or at parking meters.)	\$10
Monthly pass (Ramsey Lake Health Centre or Sudbury Outpatient Centre)	\$80
Staff/Visitor Lots <i>(Ramsey Lake Health Centre: P8 Sudbury Outpatient Clinic – front parking lot)</i>	
1 st hour	\$3
2 nd hour	\$2
3 rd hour and each following hour	\$1
Daily maximum	\$6
1 day pass (Unlimited in/out for 24 hours to all Patient/Visitor and Staff/Visitor parking lots. Not valid in the Pay & Display lot or at parking meters.)	\$10
Monthly pass (Ramsey Lake Health Centre or Sudbury Outpatient Centre)	\$80
Pay & Display Lot (In front of the North East Cancer Centre)	
1 st hour	\$3
2 nd hour	\$2
3 rd hour and each following hour	\$1
Daily maximum	\$10

- *Metered parking at both the Ramsey Lake Health Centre (RLHC) and Sudbury Outpatient Centre (SOC) costs \$2.00 per hour.*
- *Monthly and weekly parking passes can be purchased from one of the Finance offices located at:*
 - *Ramsey Lake Health Centre: South Tower Level 1*
 - *Sudbury Outpatient Centre: Lower Level, Room M001*



- 4) Are visitors provided with instructions about how the parking system works when they purchase a monthly or weekly parking pass?

Printed instructions for how the parking system works will be available from the Finance Department.

- 5) How will I know which lot I am parked in? For larger parking lots, how will I know where I have parked?

As you drive into each parking lot, signage located at the entrance of the lot will identify the type of parking lot you are entering. The colour of the parking lot signs will help to identify the type of parking lot:

→ Patient/Visitor Lots will have orange on the signs

→ Staff/Visitor Lots will have blue on the signs

→ The Pay and Display Lot will have green on the signs

Also, the parking ticket that is issued by the parking gate when entering a parking lot includes the name of the parking lot that was entered. Please refer to the Parking Lot Maps for more information.
